Children's Friendship Training is a 10-week, evidence-based, social skills group-format for Thames Valley District School Board students from grades 2 to 7. This parent-assisted social skills group has been proven effective for individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) who are demonstrating emerging social skills and are motivated to make friends.

Each session will focus on teaching a different social skill, and students will be given the opportunity to practice these skills in session through the use of role-play and play based activities (e.g. board games, sports etc.). During each session, parents are taught simultaneously how to assist their child in developing friendships by providing coaching and feedback through homework assignments designed to practice the skills.
