### **News:**

We made it through the first week back to in person learning! Great job everyone, it is the combined efforts of everyone in our school community that have allowed us to have this success. Please continue to stay the course. With the significant drop in temperature, we ask families to ensure that they are sending students to school with all of the appropriate winter gear (perhaps even an extra pair of mitts/gloves, just in case) to ensure that they can participate in and enjoy our outdoor activities.

### **COVID Protocol Updates/Reminders:**

**FYI REVISED COVID 19 Screener:** On the recommendation of the Chief Medical Officer of Health, a more sensitive COVID-19 symptom list is being reinstated for daily active screening of all students and staff in schools and child care. Anyone who has symptoms suggestive of COVID-19 or is a confirmed positive case must self-isolate, regardless of vaccination status. Updates have been made to the COVID-19 Screening tools for staff and students. The updated version of the screening tool (dated January 6, 2022) is posted on [Ontario.ca/SchoolScreening](https://ontario.ca/SchoolScreening) and is to be used by any TVDSB staff/student who is attending a TVDSB site or school.

**Daily Screening by students** - By completing your daily screener through the TVDSB links that have been provided. Your results (able to attend, not able to attend) is sent directly to Admin at the school. Parents/Staff do not need to do anything further.

**Students who show symptoms during the day** - new screener is back to the original, tighter criteria for screening. If a student is showing symptoms, we will be calling for pick up and siblings will be going home as well. Isolation time frames vary based on vaccination status.

**Positive case** - it will only be the student who tested positive (and their siblings) who are sent home - not classmates, staff or bus mates.

**Rapid Antigen Test** (2 tests/student) will be distributed to students once they are received. Approx half the school has received theirs, we hope to receive the next shipment early next week.

**Technology:** At this time we are not asking that tech be returned; however, it has been suggested that students could bring their loaned device, or their own personal device (with parent permission, and the understanding that it is their responsibility to take care of the device - the school will not be responsible for lost/stolen/damaged devices) back and forth each day. This will facilitate the continued use of Google Classroom and Brightspace for all of your students and make it easier for teachers to deliver a consistent and less interrupted curriculum to everyone.

**Grade 1&2 Reading Program** supported by Gr 7 & 8 students will be able to continue. We will be reaching out to families that are involved to reconfirm that they continue to consent to their child participating.
