We are also happy to accept any used gift bags you may have piling up at home - they make a fun way for students to carry home their new purchases.

Sales notes: All students may shop at the used book sale the week of November 27 - December 1. Students may select up to 4 items for each dollar they bring. We will not be making change. The money you send is a donation which will be gratefully received. If you are sending more than a couple dollars, please have a chat with your child about how many items you would like them to bring (ie. you may wish to send a \$10.00 bill but may not appreciate having 40 books come home 😊)

We will update you on the status of the sale at the end of the first week of sales - if there are items remaining, we will run the following week as well.
